## SCHOOL PROGRAMME OF STUDY

### ENGLISH



Year 3 will be covering a range of exciting texts including: The Enormous Crocodile; Tuesday; Stone Age Boy; How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth; The Great Kapok Tree, The Worst Witch; How to Train Your Dragon and Ice Trap. Using these books we will be writing narratives, play scripts, poetry, letters and much more!

### MATHS



Year 3 will cover a range of topics in Maths. These include Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Fractions, Money, Shape, Time and Mass and Capacity.

Please ensure you regularly login into Times Tables Rockstars each week.

### SCIENCE



In Science, the children will be using their investigative, exploration and researching skills to learn about the following topics: Forces and Magnets, Rocks, Animals including Humans, Light, and Plants. Using all of the skills they develop over the year their final term will be diving into different Explorify tasks.

### HISTORY/ GEOGRAPHY



In History, the children will explore different civilizations and significant battles and compare life in the past to the present through the topics of Ancient Egypt, Stone Age & The Romans. In Geography, the children will develop key geographical skills through the following topics: Exploring the UK and Europe, Antarctica and The Rainforest.

### PSHE



Within PSHE we will cover a range of topics, which will support the children with their understanding of internet safety, their relationships with others and living in a diverse world. The topics include Relationships, Health and Wellbeing and Living in the Wider World.

### ART/ DT



Throughout the year, the children will be using a range of skills such as sketching, painting, designing, creating and evaluating. Our topics include European Art, Stone Age Cave Painting and Roman Shields.

### FRENCH



In French, alongside developing cultural awareness the children will learn vocabulary through songs, stories and activities. In Year 3 there is a focus on, Animals, Instruments, Seasons, Icecreams and 'I am able'.

### MUSIC



In Year 3, children learn about key musical elements including rhythm, timing, pitch and tempo through playing the recorder and learning songs such as 'Let your spirit fly' and 'Three little birds'. In addition, children will learn to play the ocarina.

### RE



In our RE lessons we will be thinking about the key questions: What do different people believe about God? Why is the Bible important for Christians today? What does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today? Why do people pray? Why are festivals important to communities?

### PE



Year 3 will be learning about the importance of teamwork, strategy, skill building and staying active through: Basketball, Dance, Gymnastics, Tennis, Athletics and Rounders.

Please make sure children are wearing the appropriate kit: plain white/ red polo top, black bottoms.

### COMPUTING



Through iPads, computers and other various technology Year 3 will master skills in relation to databases, typing email, PowerPoint, coding and spreadsheets. Throughout the year, we will also focus on internet safety.

### HOMWORK

Children must be reading every day. Spellings will be set on Spelling Shed weekly on a Friday. An additional task relevant to the week's learning will also be set.
