OR

If the family have moved, and they have moved to within 2 miles of the school.

OR

If the family have moved nearer to the school from where they were living previously.

Year 6 parents may also want to start booking tours of secondary school again, please let the School Office know via the School App (absence reporting)/telephone or email to let us know if your child is attending any tours so we can note this on the register.

Birthdays

We have had several enquiries about how birthdays are celebrated at school. We ask parents do not bring sweets, fruit or gifts to hand out to your child's friends as this can cause additional financial pressures to other families and exclude children with dietary needs.
