VISIT TO FENN BELL CONSERVATION

As part of the Year 3 Geography and English curriculum, the children have been learning about Rainforest habitats; the oldest and most impressive ecosystems in the world. With this in mind, we would like to take the children from Year 3 to The Fenn Bell Conservation project on **Tuesday 6th May**. The children will have the opportunity to explore the many enclosures to observe the exotic creatures via a guided tour from one of the conservation rangers and attend feeding and conservation workshops.

We will be travelling by coach and will leave school at approximately 9:30am, and will return for the usual departure time of 3:10pm
