SATS week will soon be upon us: week beginning Monday 11th May 2026.

The children have been working extremely hard in school to prepare for the Year 6 Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs) and are determined to try their best, applying all of their learned skills and knowledge from Years 3 – 6.

We would like to invite all year 6 children to arrive at school ten minutes prior to the usual start time for the school day between Monday 11th May and Thursday 14th May (**back gate only**). They are welcome to arrive at their classrooms at **8.30am** on the days of the SATs to give them the opportunity to have some breakfast together. It is not compulsory but would be a nice start to the morning for the class to share together. Please let the class teacher know if your child has any dietary requirements.

As shared at the Year 6 Parent SATs workshop, the dates of the SATs testing are as follows:

Monday 11 th May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) paper 1 (GPS questions) and 2 (Spelling)
Tuesday 12 th May	English reading paper
Wednesday 13 th May	Maths arithmetic 1, Maths reasoning 2
Thursday 14 th May	Maths reasoning 3

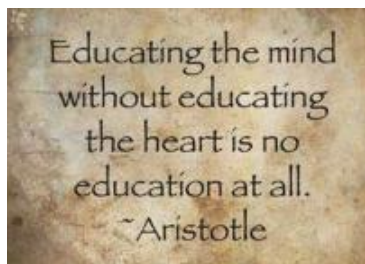
Finally, SATs do not test the following qualities:
