### YEAR R VISIT TO MINNIS BAY

Dear Reception Parents and Carers,

Our topic for Term 6 is 'Under the Sea'. We will be broadening our 'Knowledge and Understanding of the World' through lots of exciting activities in school. To further enhance our understanding and to provide a fully immersive experience, we would like to take the children from Year R to visit Minnis Bay Beach on **Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026**.

The cost of the trip will be £14.35 **per child**. This is the payment for our coach travel.

We would appreciate payment via ParentPay **by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2026**.

While contributions are not mandatory, the trip will only proceed if sufficient funds are raised. No child will be excluded based on contributions. If you are experiencing financial difficulties, please contact the school office.

We will be travelling by coach and will leave school at 9:15am therefore the children will need to arrive promptly at 8.40am. We will return for the usual school departure time of 3:10pm (traffic permitting).

During the trip, the children will learn more about the seaside through exploration, and will play on the sand and have a paddle in the sea (up to ankle height), in small groups accompanied by adults. They will eat their lunch and have an ice cream from a local ice-cream shop.

**Your child may bring a maximum of £2.00 for an ice cream. Please put the spending money in a named envelope, this will be looked after by an adult.**

Please dress your child in their PE kit (black shorts and a white or red PE top), with suitable footwear - crocs/wet shoes are ideal for paddling! Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather, e.g. children will need a rain-mac if it is raining.

#### **Your child will need:**

- A packed lunch
- A bottle of water
- An application of once-a-day sun cream the morning of the trip
- A sun hat
- Suitable footwear e.g. crocs, wet shoes for paddling.

A small towel to sit on/dry themselves after paddling

Your child will be responsible for all items brought on the trip, so a rucksack clearly labelled appropriate.

#### **Your child may also want to bring:**

- A named bucket and spade
- £2.00 spending money
