FOOD AND DRINK

✿ A catering team are provided who work from the kitchen. They prepare nutritious, tasty meals that ensure the group is full of energy needed for adventure.

Alternatives for specific dietary needs are available for all meals.

Sample Menu Day 1: LUNCH - Sandwiches, salad, crisps and cakes DINNER - Roast Chicken dinner with veggies, roast potatoes and Yorkshire pudding. Choc ice or pudding pots.

Day 2: BREAKFAST - Continental, cereal and toast LUNCH - Jacket potatoes and salad DINNER - Pasta bake and garlic bread. Cake and custard. Day 3: BREAKFAST - Continental, cereal and toast LUNCH - Sandwiches, salad, crisps and cakes

✿ All taps around the site are drinking water. They will also supply a tanker of fresh water for refill within the lunching areas. There are reusable cups available to use but it is advised that everyone brings a reusable bottle with them.


