PSHE: relationships, safety first, one world, digital wellbeing, money matters, puberty & me

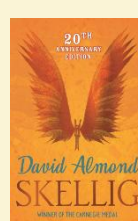
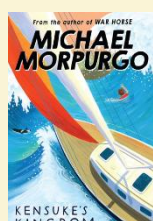
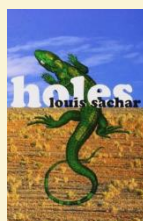
PE: basketball, football, gymnastics/dance, racket skills, handball & athletics & rounders;
