All pupils engage in at least 30 minutes of physical activity during the school day, in addition to curriculum PE.	• Introduce structured playground activities led by trained Play Leaders. • Refresh playground equipment and activity zones. • Continue or introduce initiatives such as the Daily Mile or active classroom breaks. • Provide training for lunchtime supervisors to facilitate inclusive games. • Monitor activity levels through pupil voice and observations.
Improve the quality of PE teaching through professional development	• Deliver CPD through specialist sports coaches working alongside staff. • Use team teaching and coaching cycles to develop teacher expertise. • Provide moderation opportunities and staff meetings focused on assessment in PE. • Monitor teaching through lesson observations and learning walks.
Increase participation in extra-curricular sport and competitive opportunities	• Audit pupil interests and tailor clubs accordingly. • Introduce a wider range of clubs (e.g. dance, yoga, dodgeball, boccia, orienteering). • Track participation by key groups and target invitations where needed. • Enter additional local competitions and festivals. • Celebrate participation and success through assemblies and newsletters.
