PROGRAMME OF STUDY

ENGLISH



Year 1 will be covering a range of exciting texts including; Be Who You Are, The Family Book, Funnybones, Litterbug Doug, Beegu, Cops and Robbers.

Our activities will include guided and paired reading, comprehension, spelling, writing, phonics and sentence structure. We will also practice our pre cursive handwriting script.

MATHS



Year 1 cover the Maths topics of: Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Estimating, fractions, problem solving, data handling, measuring, shape and space. The maths curriculum provides opportunities to develop their ability in mental calculations too.

SCIENCE



Through research, investigation and exploration the following topics will be learnt about:

Animals including Humans, seasonal change, Everyday materials and plants. Children will also use experiments to improve pupils' science knowledge, use of scientific vocabulary and reasoning skills.

HISTORY/ GEOGRAPHY



In History, the children will explore different civilizations and compare life in the past to the present through the topics of toys in the past, homes in the past and looking at different castles.

In Geography, the children will research the local area, information about the UK and different countries and comparing climates.

PSHE



Personal, Social and Health Education and Citizenship is designed to develop clear values and attitudes, to help your child to make and sustain relationships, to think critically, to be self-reliant, self-disciplined and to express opinions confidently.

ART/ DT



During DT the children will design and make a range of products using paper, card, watercolours, natural materials and clay. In Art lessons, the children will explore using a range of materials, as well as observational drawing and painting. We will also explore the work of other artists.

MUSIC



Music lessons cover exploring sounds made by different instruments and composing our own simple rhythms and patterns. We will also appreciate music by significant composers.

RE



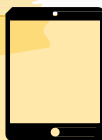
Religious Education will include the study of a variety of festivals and religions. These will include: Judaism, Hinduism and Christianity.
