PROGRAMME OF STUDY

ENGLISH



Year 2 will be covering a range of exciting texts; The Colour Monster, The Fish who could Wish, George's Marvellous Medicine, Red Riding Hood was Rotten, Non-fiction explanation texts on frogs, The Pirate Next Door. Through these books we will cover newspaper reports, narratives, play scripts, poetry, letter writing and much more!

MATHS



Year 2 cover the Maths topics of: Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Fractions, Measurement of time, length and height. By the end of the year, children should be able to record their multiplications in 2s, 5s and 10s.

SCIENCE



Through practical research, investigation of real world experiences and exploration the following topics will be taught: Living things and their habitats, Materials, Animals including humans and Plants.

HISTORY/ GEOGRAPHY



In History, the children will explore different civilizations and significant events and compare life in the past to the present through the topics of The Great Fire of London, Kings and Queens and Intrepid Explorers. In Geography, the children will develop key geographical skills through the following topics; Where do I live? Farms and Map Makers.

PSHE



Year 2 topics focus on Healthy Relationships, Living in the Wider World and Health and Wellbeing. Our curriculum includes learning about the human life cycle (not reproduction), how our bodies change as we grow from a baby to a toddler to a child to an adult, the importance of keeping private parts private and the correct terminology for private parts.

ART/ DT



Year 2 will be sketching, painting, cooking, designing, creating and evaluating using a range of media. Topics include: Colour Chaos, Making Fire Engines, Self-portraits, Fruit salads, Observational Sketches and Puppets.

MUSIC



In Year 2, children learn about key musical elements including rhythm, timing, pitch and tempo through playing the recorder and learning songs such as 'Hands, Feet, Heart' and 'Friendship Song'.

RE



Year 2 will learn about and compare a range of different religions including Christianity, Hinduism, Judaism and Islam.

PE



Year 2 will be learning about the importance of teamwork, strategy, skill building and staying active through; Basketball, Dance, Gymnastics, Tennis, Athletics and Cricket. **Please make sure children are wearing the appropriate kit: Plain white/ red polo top, black bottoms and plain trainers.**

COMPUTING



Through iPads, computers and other various technology Year 2 will master skills in relation to Word Processing, Coding, Online Safety, and Spreadsheets and using technology for a task.
