SCHOOL PROGRAMME OF STUDY

ENGLISH



Year 4 will be covering a range of exciting texts; The Iron Man, Lion the Witch and the Wardrobe, The Last Bear, Esio Trot, Sugarcane Juice and Ice Palace.

Through these books, we will cover newspaper reports, narratives, play scripts, poetry, letter writing and much more!

MATHS



Year 4 cover the Maths topics of: number, place value, estimating, rounding, fractions, multiplication and division, problem solving, data handling, measuring, shape and space.

Please ensure you regularly log in into Times Tables Rockstars & prepare for weekly times tables testing.

SCIENCE



Through research, investigation and exploration the following topics will be explored:

States of Matter, Animals including Humans, Sound, Electricity and Living things and their habitats.

We will also be looking at a range of interesting Scientists.

HISTORY/ GEOGRAPHY



In History, the children will explore different civilizations and significant battles and compare life in the past to the present through the topics of The Maya civilization, The Anglo Saxons & The Victorians. In Geography, the children will develop key geographical skills through the following topics; Rivers & The Water Cycle, India and Extreme Earth.

PSHE



Through our carefully designed curriculum we have a key focus on keeping the children safe and learning about healthy relationships. Year 4 topics include: Living in the Wider World, Health and Wellbeing and Relationships.

ART/ DT



Year 4 will be sketching, painting, cooking, designing, creating and evaluating using a range of media. Topics include:

Landscapes, Sculptures, Painting, Electrical systems, Printing, Drawing and Cooking.

FRENCH



In French, alongside developing cultural awareness the children will learn vocabulary through songs, stories and activities. In Year 4, there is a focus on Myself, Family, Home, Classroom, At the Café and Weather.

MUSIC



In Year 4, children learn about key musical elements including rhythm, timing, pitch and tempo through playing the Recorder. Recorder lessons will be on a Wednesday. Children do not need a Recorder as these are provided.

RE



Year 4 will learn about and compare a range of different religions including Christianity, Hinduism, Judaism, Islam.

PE



Year 4 will be learning about the importance of teamwork, strategy, skill building and staying active through; Football, Dance, Gymnastics, Tennis, Athletics and Cricket.

Please make sure children are wearing the appropriate kit: Plain white/ red polo top, black bottoms.

COMPUTING



Through iPads, computers and other various technology Year 4 will master skills in relation to Online Safety, Making Music, Effective Searching, Hardware, Word Processing, Logo, Animation, Coding and Spreadsheets.

HOMEWORK

Children must be reading every day. Spellings will be set on Spelling Shed weekly, along with a weekly times table focus. Both will be tested on a Friday. An additional task relevant to the week's learning will be set weekly, and be due in every Friday.
