SCHOOL PROGRAMME OF STUDY

ENGLISH



Year 5 will be covering a range of exciting texts; Prometheus and Pandora, Who Let the Gods Out?, Red Miss Take, Beowulf, The BFG, The Titanic, Matilda. Through these books we will cover newspaper reports, narratives, play scripts, poetry, letter writing and much more!

MATHS



Year 5 cover the Maths topics of: Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Fractions, Decimals and Percentages, Perimeter and Area, Statistics.
Please ensure you regularly log in into Times Tables Rockstars & prepare for weekly times tables testing.

SCIENCE



Through research, investigation and exploration the following topics will be learnt about: Forces, Earth and Space, Living Things and Habitats, Properties and Changes of materials and Animals including Humans. We will also be learning more about famous scientists such as Isaac Newton.

HISTORY/ GEOGRAPHY



In History, the children will explore different civilizations and significant battles and compare life in the past to the present through the topics of Ancient Greece, The Vikings & The Titanic. In Geography, the children will develop key geographical skills through the following topics; Exploring Scandinavia, North/ South America.

PSHE



Through our carefully designed curriculum we have a key focus on keeping the children safe and learning about healthy relationships. Year 5 topics include: Online Safety, Diverse Britain, It's my body, Aiming High.

ART/ DT



Year 5 will be sketching, painting, cooking, designing, creating and evaluating using a range of media. Topics include: Geometric Art, Textiles, Greek Pastries, Pop Art.

FRENCH



In French, alongside developing cultural awareness the children will learn vocabulary through songs, stories and activities. In Year 5, there is a focus on Pets, Clothes, Habitats, Planets.

MUSIC



In Year 5, children learn about key musical elements including rhythm, timing, pitch and tempo through playing a glockenspiel and learning songs such as 'Livin' on a prayer' and 'The Fresh Prince of Bel-Air'.

RE



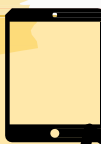
Year 5 will learn about and compare a range of different religions including Christianity, Hinduism, Judaism, Islam.
