PROGRAMME OF STUDY

ENGLISH



Year 6 will be covering a range of exciting texts: The Final Year, Wonder, Coming to England, Skellig, The Giant's Necklace, Holes, Kensuke's Kingdom and Goodnight Mr Tom plus a range of video stimulus. Through these books and video clips, we will cover newspaper reports, narratives, poetry, letter writing and much more!

MATHS



Year 6 cover the Maths topics of: Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Fractions, Decimals and Percentages, Perimeter and Area, Statistics, Ratio and Proportion and Algebra.

SCIENCE



Through research, investigation and exploration the following topics will be learnt about: Electricity, Evolution and Inheritance, Animals including Humans, Living things and their habitats, Light and Looking after our environment.

HISTORY/ GEOGRAPHY



In History, the children will explore different civilizations and significant battles and compare life in the past to the present through the topics of Crime and Punishment, Exploring the Caribbean, The Kingdom of Benin, Mountains, WW2 and Trade and Economics.

PSHE



Through our carefully designed curriculum, we have a key focus on keeping the children safe and learning about healthy relationships. Year 6 topics include Relationships, Health and Wellbeing, Living in the wider world and health and relationships.

ART/ DT



Year 6 will be sketching, sewing, painting, cooking, designing, creating and evaluating using a range of media. Topics include Sculpting Vases, Pizzas, Funky Furnishings, Landscapes, Wire Sculptures and Building bridges.

FRENCH



In French, alongside developing cultural awareness the children will learn vocabulary through songs, stories and activities. In Year 6 there is a focus on school, the weekend, me in the world and healthy lifestyles.

MUSIC



In Year 6, children learn about key musical elements including rhythm, timing, pitch and tempo through playing the ukulele and learning songs.

RE



Year 6 will learn about and compare a range of different religions including Christianity, Hinduism, Judaism, Islam and Humanism through investigating key questions.

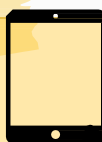
PE
